

## Past Projects

### Health Fairs

YES Network mobilized health professionals to monthly health clinics in three different target areas of Tucson. These health clinics provided families with screenings and information about important health topics for free. As part of this program, YES Network also coordinated three health fairs in these areas as well to bring community resources to residents.



### Miracle Manor Mural

Funded, in part, by PRO Neighborhoods, the Arizona Commission on the Arts and the Lego Children's Fund, the Miracle Manor Community Mural was a Neighborhood Enrichment program with a goal to build social capacity in the neighborhood. Students from the neighborhood in the One on One Mentoring Job Readiness program worked with muralist, Michael B. Shwartz, neighborhood association, and elders in the area to create a design that represented Miracle Manor then and now.

### Swan Park Rebuild

Swan Park located in the 29<sup>th</sup> Street Coalition, was rebuilt after the coalition won a grant from KaBoom. YES Network assisted the coalition with coordination and collaboration with stakeholders on this project by leading some of the committees.
